FREE health screenings. St. Francis Hospital has acquired a state of the art COMMUNITY OUTREACH VAN that can provide a brief cardiac history, blood pressure, simple blood test for Cholesterol and Diabetes screening with appropriate patient education and referrals as needed for clients above the age of 18. This van will be visiting St. Peter's on October 2, from 11 am to 3 pm and will be stationed in the parking lot between the convent and the white school. No health insurance or documents are necessary.

This year we will NOT be giving the FLU VACCINATIONS in the Pastoral Center. We have been requested to send those who usually come to the center to go to their own doctors or to go to the Senior Center on Manorhaven Blvd. The day and time there have not yet been established, but it will be necessary to register beforehand. This is not the "swine flu" vaccine, but the vaccination we usually give.

From time to time some of us have enrolled deceased family or friends on the Parish Social Ministry memorial cross in the school church. For all who wish, with your request for a name plaque, we are trying to offer a simple prayer together with you, as the name plate is placed on our cross. Please let our PSM office know if this is your wish, and enclose your telephone number on the request card.

Thank you for your constant generosity in prayer, service and goods.

Our parish pantry can use this week all personal care items, pasta sauce and soups.

Corazon de Jesus Vocational Center Update

“As often as you did it to one of the least of My brothers and sisters, you did it to Me.” Matthew 25: 40

On every piece of mail I receive from Food for the Poor this scripture is written. This is a part of their mission statement and we are grateful for their prayers, their vision, and their hard work to be the hands and feet of Christ. There are many prayers of gratitude for all of you who have generously given and loaned money so that the project could begin and for those who continue to give as we still need your help. The vocational center building is well under way and I wanted to share the good news with you. Foundation trenches were dug and the concrete base foundation was completed using cement, sand, iron, and stone. The cinder block walls have been erected. The wall columns have the metal structures in place and about 25% of them have been filled with concrete. The drainage pipes to clear the roof of rainwater have also been incorporated into the walls.

Two changes were made to the original design. The first was to build the vocational center next to a neighboring wall. This made the five side windows unnecessary, decreasing the amount of total windows to seven. The money saved there is being used to construct a maintenance-free roof made out of a concrete slab instead of a metal zinc sheet roof, this was as per the construction company suggestion.

In addition to the construction that has been done so far the vocational training equipment was purchased. It consists of 10 industrial sewing machines (with attachments), four heavy-duty irons, two semi-industrial stoves, two heavy-duty bakery mixers, and a computer. Once it arrives and clears customs it will be delivered to the site. This update is as of two to three weeks ago.

As we look upon these pictures that were sent to us we pray for those who will walk through the doors of this center. We pray that they will be encouraged and know the hope that we have in Jesus. We pray that our brothers and sisters will know that the love of God built this place and that He is with them in their struggles. We also pray for those building this center, for their safety and provision. Once again I thank you for your “Yes” to God in sharing your treasures and prayers with our brothers and sisters. This is truly what is meant by the unity of the body of Christ. May God bless us all both here and in Guatemala.
